Interim PCA Wage Increase

As you may have heard, an emergency 8.4% rate increase for PCA, Consumer Directed Community Supports (CDCS) and Consumer Support Grant (CSG) was signed by Governor Walz. This legislation also allows parents of minors and spouses to temporarily serve as PCA's. Even though the legislation has been signed, the changes still need to be approved by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

Pending approval, the interim increase and allowance of paid parent and spouse PCAs would last for 9 weeks. The effective dates of this change are projected to be December 1st, 2020 – February 7th, 2021. If not approved by the first, the program would last 9 weeks from the actual start date. For example, a December 7th start would have a February 14th end. The implementation process and details are still being discussed among advocacy agencies at this time.

As we gain clarification around these changes, we will be sure to keep you informed.

DHS Background Study Fingerprinting Update

The Department of Human Services (DHS) has returned to conducting fingerprint-based background studies that meet all state and federal requirements effective October 21st 2020.

All workers who have had a background study from April 1st, 2020 to current will need another background study completed with fingerprints.

DHS has allowed up to 30 days for fingerprints to be completed and several of the fingerprint stations/locations

are by appointment only. Please encourage your staff to complete their fingerprints as promptly as possible once they have been notified by MRCI.

Accounts Payable and Invoices:

November: All claim reimbursement and vendor invoices must be submitted to MRCI by the end of Monday, November 23rd in order to be paid on the 27th. This is due to the Holidays.

December: All claim reimbursements and vendor invoices must be submitted to MRCI by the end of Monday, December 21st in order to be paid on December 24th due to the holidays. All claims submitted after December 21st will not be paid until Friday, January 8th, 2021.
